

## ACT/SAT FEE WAIVER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

### ACT Fee Waiver

*Eligible students can take advantage of up to four registrations for the ACT.*

1. Eligible students must be currently enrolled in **11th or 12th grade**; and
2. Meet one or more of the indicators of ECONOMIC NEED listed below (check all that apply)
  - Enrolled in a federal free or reduced-price lunch program at school
  - Enrolled in a program for the economically disadvantaged (for example, a federally funded program such as GEAR UP or Upward Bound)
  - Resides in a foster home, is a ward of the state, or is homeless
  - Family receives low-income public assistance or lives in federally subsidized public housing
  - Family's total annual income is at or below the USDA levels for free or reduced-price lunches listed in the chart below

### SAT Fee Waiver

*Eligible students can take advantage of up to two registrations for the SAT.*

1. Eligible students must be currently enrolled in **11th or 12th grade**.
2. Fee waivers are available for student who meet at least one of the eligibility criteria listed here:
  - The student is enrolled in or eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
  - The student is enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids student from low-income families (for example, a TRIO program such as Upward Bound)
  - The student's family receives public assistance
  - The student lives in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home, or is homeless
  - The student is a ward of the state or an orphan
  - The student's annual family income falls within the Income Guidelines set by the USDA Food & Nutrition Service (provided at [sat.org/fee-waivers](http://sat.org/fee-waivers))
