Individual Assessment Details:

Grade 6 Florida State Assessments ELA Writing, ELA Reading, and Math are paper based. Students must participate in both Day 1 and Day 2 and remain for the entire testing duration.

Grade 7 Florida State Assessments ELA Writing, ELA Reading, and Math are computer based. Students will be required to wear earbuds/headphones during the FSA ELA/Reading assessment. Students are encouraged to bring their own to each daily testing session. Students must participate in both Day 1 and Day 2 and remain for the entire testing duration. Only students currently enrolled in Mathematics 2 or Pre-Algebra will sit for FSA Math.

Grade 8 Florida State Assessments ELA Writing, ELA Reading, and Math are computer based. The **NGSSS Science** is paper based. Students will be required to wear earbuds/headphones during the FSA ELA/Reading assessment. Students are encouraged to bring their own to each daily testing session. Students must participate in both Day 1 and Day 2 and remain for the entire testing duration.

Civics End of Course (EOC) Exam is computer based and will count toward 30% of the course final grade. All students enrolled in J/J Civics must sit for the respective EOC. Students must remain for the entire testing duration.

Algebra 1 End of Course (EOC) Exam is computer based and considered a pass/fail assessment. Students currently enrolled in Algebra 1 will sit for the respective EOC but NOT sit for FSA Math. Students must participate in both Day 1 and Day 2 and remain for the entire test duration, allowed to test up to one-half school day.

It is important for grade 6-8 students to attend their grade level class meetings. At these meetings, students will review their individual academic history and be informed of the assessments he/she is required to take.
